The presentation will cover background, methods and findings of 3 studies using population databases to obtain insight into the question "What do we know about the risk of asthma and the environment?" The three studies are:

- 1. What is the *lifetime risk* for developing asthma?
- 2. Does *acute exposure* to air pollution impact on asthma risk?
- 3. If you have asthma, does *chronic exposure* to air pollution increase your risk of developing COPD (disease progression)?
