Admissibility

- were awarded a Ph.D. degree no earlier than Sept 31, 2013. A candidate with an M.D. can also apply if he/she has completed an M.Sc.
- language and writing proficiency in English is required.
- proficiency in French is an asset.
- expertise in managing large administrative governmental health databases is an asset.

Research field

The selected candidate will be working in the field of pharmacoepidemiology of childhood asthma to explore the long-term outcomes of children with asthma in their first years of life using large administrative governmental health databases.

Secondary analyses of large administrative and clinical databases of children with asthma.
