Dr. Islam Elkholi is a Postdoctoral Fellow in the Department of Oncology at McGill University. He completed his M.D. at Mansoura University, Egypt in 2016 and subsequently obtained his PhD in Molecular Biology from the Université de Montréal in 2022, under the supervision of Drs. Jean-François Côté and Morag Park. His thesis work focused on discovering mechanisms underlying the survival and awakening of dormant disseminated breast cancer cells with the overarching and long-term goal of preventing metastatic relapses in breast cancer patients. In Dr. April Rose's lab, he is currently holding a Canadian Cancer Society postdoctoral award to investigate the signaling dependencies and therapeutic vulnerabilities of non-V600 BRAF mutated metastatic/aggressive cancers.
